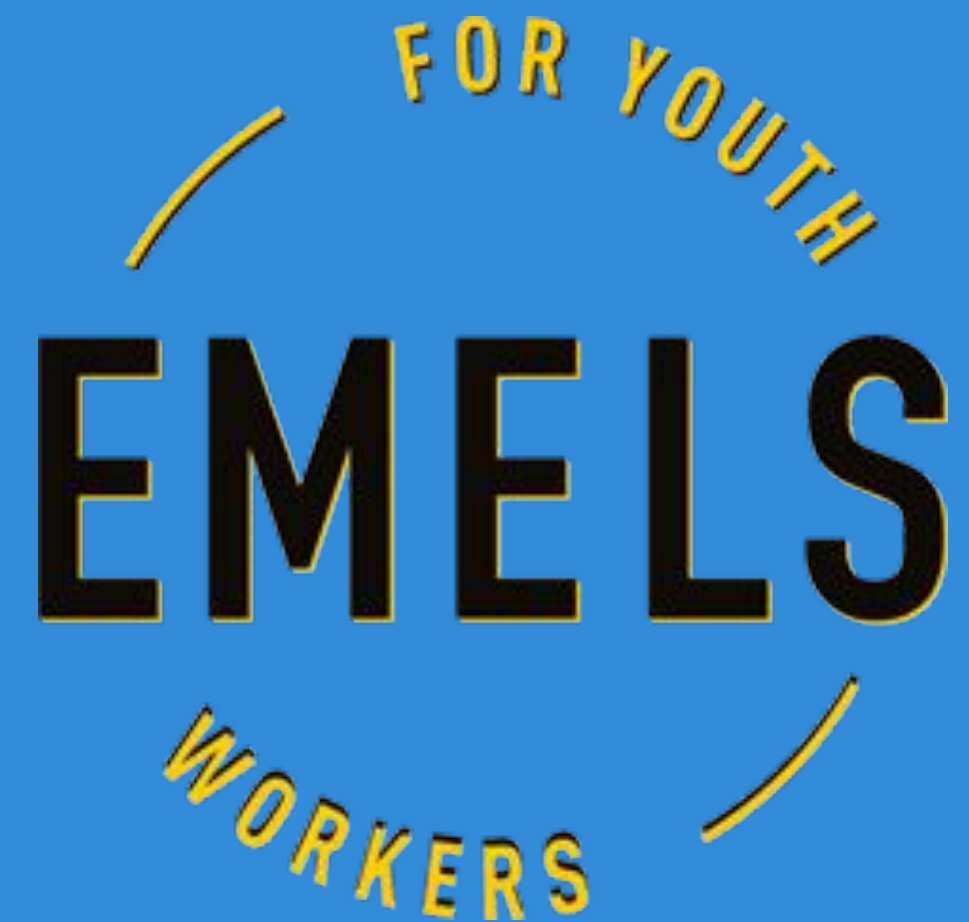

European Media Literacy Standard for Youth Workers

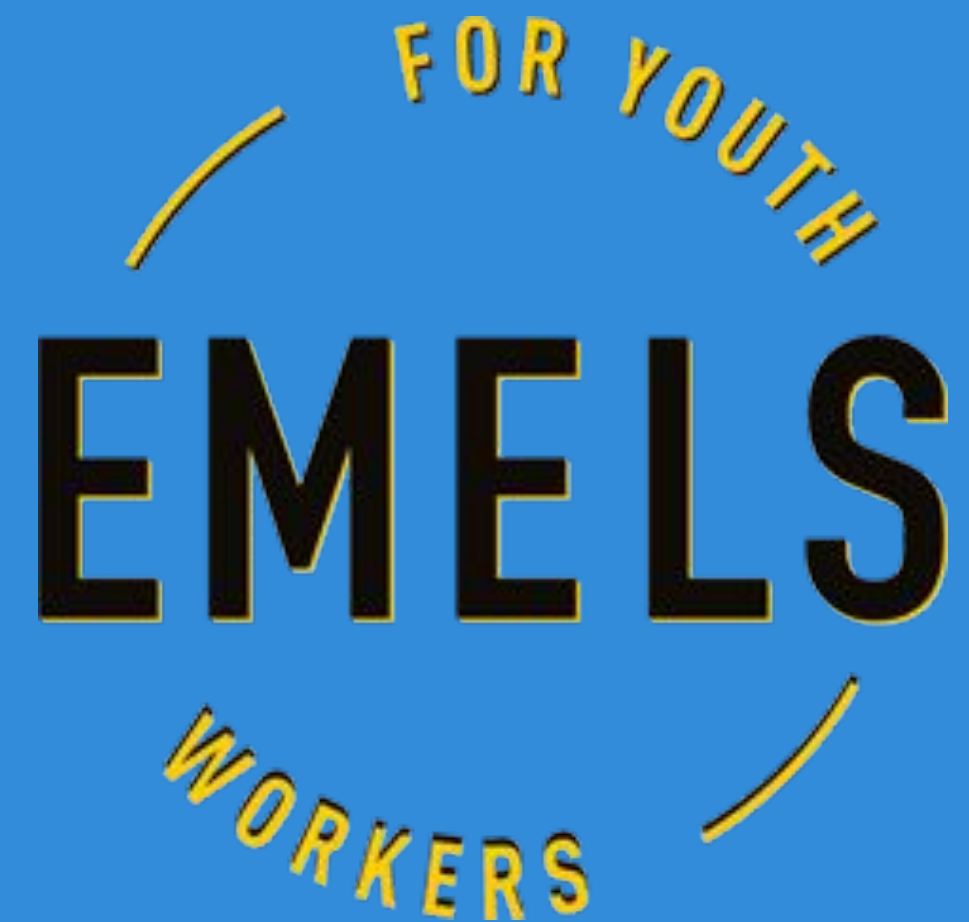
Media education professionals noticed a need to have a common reference framework in the field of youth work, on what it means to be digitally savvy in an increasingly digitized world. Thus, they created EMELS with the aim to become a tool for youth workers to improve young people's media literacy and to help raise the quality of youth work and training in the field of media education. EMELS can be used in different settings: youth-led organisations, organisations for youth, informal groups or youth services and public authorities.



European Media Literacy Standard for Youth Workers

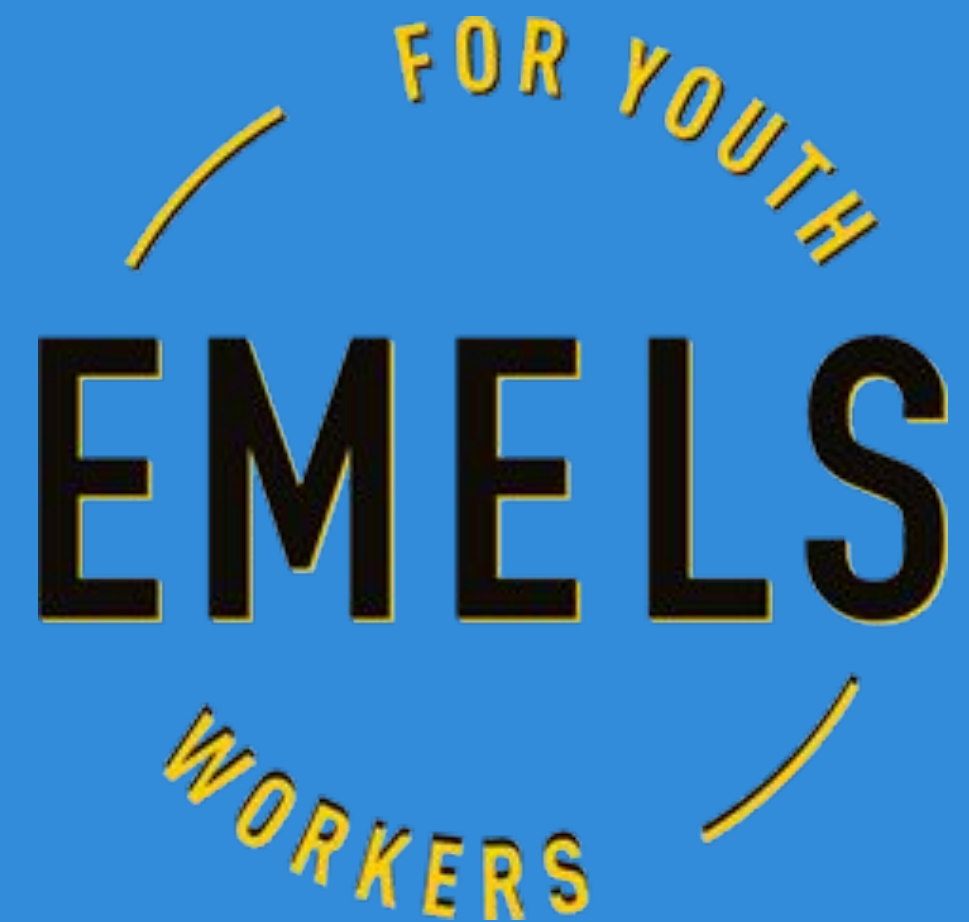
This standard refers to 5 areas of digital competence:

1. Information and data
2. Media creation and communication
3. Resistance and Empowerment
4. Understanding media usage of children and young people
5. Training skills and development
